


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




Pain






Pain Scale

Instructions For Using Provider Assisted Scanning For Patients Who Cannot Point

- Position the communication board where the patients can see it (~12"/ ~30cm). If patient wears glasses make sure they are on. Remember to speak clearly and slowly
- Identify a reliable yes and no gesture that the patient can produce. Post a notice above the patient's bed to indicate what the yes and no gestures are.
- Have patient focus on the desired message.
- Point to the first row and ask if the message is in that row. If the patient does not indicate "yes" move to the next row and move through the rows until the patient indicates "yes'.
 Always have the patient confirm the choice
- Point to the first cell in the select row and ask if that is the desired choice. If the patient does not indicate "yes" move to the next cell and move through the cells until the patient indicates "yes'.
- When the patient has selected message, confirm it verbally.
- Ask if the patient wants to say something else. If the patient indicates yes, ask whether there
 is another message on that board that the patient wishes to communicate or whether the
 patient wants something on another board; if so, offer each board in succession and have the
 patient indicate whether that is the desired board.





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
